Students who have enrolled for a course will be able to withdraw from it *until seven days after the first day of their course*. In this case all fees less 10% or \$500.00, whichever is the lesser amount, will be refunded. (The cancellation fee may vary depending on course length). In all other cases, cancellations and refunds are solely at the discretion of the school.
